Guidelines for anniversaries:

To be sure readers of *The State Journal* will not be disappointed over coverage of anniversaries, here are a few rules to be followed for publication of this information.

Information about the anniversary and a photograph, if desired, should be in our office no later than 1 p.m. Tuesday before the Sunday on which the anniversary will be published. If desired, the announcement can run in Wednesday’s paper. The deadline for Wednesday publication is noon Monday.

The announcement can be published before or after the anniversary.

There is no charge for publication of announcements.

Anniversary announcements cannot be taken over the telephone.

Pictures used in anniversary announcements will be returned if a stamped, self-addressed envelope is included, or they may be picked up in the front office after the announcement is published.
