

# NEWS OF RECORD

## RESTAURANT INSPECTIONS

The Franklin County Department of Health inspects restaurants and other public eating establishments at least twice a year. Food storage, preparation, personnel, equipment facilities and other health conditions are checked. The inspections can be viewed on the health department's Web site, www.fchd.org.

Each asterisk (\*) indicates one critical violation. If an establishment has a critical violation, it fails the inspection and will be inspected again with 10 days. The scores for the regular and follow-up inspections are shown for establishments that had critical violations.

A perfect score is 100. Points are subtracted if department guidelines are not met. Below is a breakdown of scores.

For establishments listed under food/service establishments there are two scores. The first is for the food service and the second is for the retail section of the establishment.

85-100 without a critical violation means in the establishment is in compliance with the department's guidelines.

70-84 without a critical violation calls for another inspection within 30 days.

70 and below means the establishment is automatically served notice of the department's intention to suspend its permit.

Arandas Mexican Restaurant, 193 Versailles Road, 89, back screen door in bad repair; meat item (thawed hamburger patties) stored over ready-to-eat product in side cooler unit; meat stored over refried beans in walk-in cooler; handle of ice scoop found in product (corrected); walk-in cooler gasket in bad repair; dumpster lids opened; drain cover damaged; light in side cooler next to drink not shielded.

Arby's, #8 Hudson Hollow Road, 93, drive-through window not self-closing; freezer gasket not sealing properly at bottom level; bottom shelves of tables next to three-compartment sink soiled over time; personal bag found next to single service item.

Arby's, 321 Versailles Road, 99, light not shielded in turnover warmer.

Bondurant Middle School, Bondurant Drive, 100

Bridgeport Elementary School, 411 Kings Daughters Drive, 91, steam table at right serving line out of order and not heating properly; facility does not have adequate heating facilities for proper food service; food (sauces) improperly stored in basket; low water pressure at student restroom hand sinks; air drying device in girls restroom out of order.

Burger King, 9 Hudson Hollow Road, 98, faucet of mop sink leaking at back flow; personal item stored

on shelf with paper products (corrected).

Capital Fitness, 193 Versailles Road, 83, personal food stored in reach-in cooler; shelves are raw wood and not sealed and easily cleaned; dishes are not being rinsed (manager stated they are washed and sanitized and air dried); sponges used for dish washing; no self-closing doors on restrooms; no covered waste can in public restroom; cleaners improperly stored by food; paint/tools improperly stored in dish wash area; mop improperly stored on floor.

Country Place, 60 Old Sheep Pen Road, 98, no thermometer provided in reach-in freezer; floor in ladies restroom in bad repair.

DBA Shell Express, 244 Versailles Road, 99, soft drink machine spigots sticky.

Dollar General, 1151 U.S. 127 south, 96, thermometer in ice cream freezer broken; broken vent in ladies restroom, mold/spoiled ceiling tiles along back wall near pet food.

Dollar Tree, 363 Versailles Road, 99, coolers in back unclean on bottom.

Elkhorn Middle School, 1060 E. Main St., 98, wash temperature on automatic dishwasher too cool.

Elkhorn Middle School concessions, 1060 E. Main St., 87, no thermometer in reach-in cooler provided; utensils improperly stored in food preparation hand sink; single-service food containers stored directly on the floor; cleaners improperly stored directly on/by food grade gloves and food wrap over cooking equipment; brooms/dusts pans stored on floor; rust water out of faucet in restroom.

Family Dollar #498, 209 Eastwood Shopping Center, 98, out of date hot dogs in cooler.

Five Star Food, 1620 Versailles Road, 97, corrected to 100, meal container in deli not properly labeled; paint coat heat plate for cooking chipped and in bad repair.

Frankfort High School, 328 Shelby St., 100

Frankfort Regional Medical Center, 299 Kings Daughters Drive, 94, food warmer and walk-in cooler/freezer gaskets torn and in bad repair; automatic dishwasher final rinse temperature too cool; all clean dishes must be re-sanitized in three-compartment sink until repair on dishwasher complete; hand sinks in men's locker room not draining properly.

Garcia's Restaurant, 105 Brighton Park Blvd., 92, raw meat stored over cheese and diced vegetables; ice scoop handle in ice; wet wiping cloth placed on countertop; metal containers stacked without being air dried; floor boards in bad repair; no light shield for light in walk-in cooler; shoes found on food shelf.

Gas N Go, 2548 U.S. 127 south, 97, mop sink not drained properly; dumpster lid open (corrected) lights not shielded in retail cooler.

Ginza Hibachi Japanese, 111 W. Ridge Drive, 94, few containers with white food product not labeled; shelf in food preparation area in need of cleaning; outer door in kitchen has hole.

Good Shepherd School, 316 Wapping St., 98, wiping cloth not stored in required amount of sanitizer; light over can storage cabinet not shielded.

sponge used for dishwashing; no hand cleaner or sanitary towels provided at the dish wash area hand sink.

Kroger, 1389 U.S. 127 south, 99, thermometer in frozen meats freezer in bad repair; floor board in bad repair under three compartment sink; lights not shielded in deli walk-in freezer/cooler.

Long John Silvers/A&W, 1234 U.S. 127, 95, drip tray in bad repair at soft service ice cream dispenser; one drip tray missing; walk-in freezer door gasket in bad repair and not sealing properly; gauge on automatic dishwasher no working properly; pans not air dried before stacking into storage; personal item (apron) stored by food and food containers; broom/dust pan on floor by back door.

LongHorn Steakhouse, 101 W. Ridge Plaza, 97, no test kit for bar sanitizer; metal containers stacked without completely being air dried; personal items stored over products.

Papa John's, 939 Louisville Road, 95, cutting board over cans in bad repair; outside dumpster found with opened side lid; personal jacket found on beverages.

Peaks Mill Elementary School, 100 Peaks Mill Road, 100

Personal Touch Catering, 545 E. Main St., 98, hair restraints not worn during food preparation; areas if walls/floor in bad repair.

Starbucks, 100 Jett Drive, 98, jacket improperly stored on food storage shelf; brooms stored directly on the floor.

sprayer at automatic dishwasher is leaking at faucet.

Thai Smile, 1139 Century Plaza, 88, owner stated that breeding was changed once a week, breeding must be changed every four hours or less; ice scoop at ice maker stored with handle down in ice; enamel painted pan on three compartment sink and plastic pans cracked and in bad repair; sponges used for dish washing also automatic dishwasher leaking into a pan; tongs stored on oven handles; mop sink soiled; light in dry food storage area no properly shielded; purse improperly stored directly on single-service food/drink containers.
